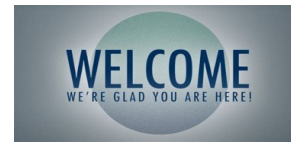

“He Gave Food to All”

Charity held the higher powers of Christ’s soul in stillness and in an enjoyment of the same bless which he now enjoys. This same charity kept him constantly raised up to his Father in reverence, love, praise and veneration, leading him to pray fervently for the needs of all persons and to offer up all his works for the honor of his Father. Christ our Lover labored for us both exteriorly and interiorly, with true fidelity. We cannot thoroughly understand his charity, for it flowed forth from the fathomless spring of the Holy Spirit in a way that transcends the experience of all creatures who ever received charity, since Christ was both God and human in one person.

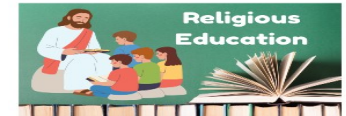
